The following are suggested guidelines for your Discipleship Moment. Please take them seriously! ***Please note that it is not appropriate for Discipleship Moments to be used for advocacy of causes or concerns.***

- 1) We are trying to keep our worship experiences as parallel as possible. Please plan for all 3 services to hear the same presentation on the same day and preferably (if possible) from the same person.
- 2) Be BRIEF! Two minutes is plenty!
- 3) Be ENERGETIC! The goal is to persuade people to a positive end!
- 4) Be CONFIDENT! Come prepared with your thoughts in order – preferably written.
- 5) The Discipleship Moment comes immediately before the offering during the order of worship. In order to maintain flow and to help make your point, you are asked to present the Discipleship Moment, then call the ushers forward, offer the offertory prayer, and hand the offering plates to the ushers.
- 6) Be ENCOURAGING! “What does this mean to ME?” is what the person in the pew wants to know. “Why have we done this in the middle of the worship service right with the offering?” Because it is an opportunity for SERVICE! So please tell the congregation how they can SERVE, GIVE, AID, LEARN, GROW!
- 7) KEY things to mention when doing your presentation:
 - a. God asks us to give of our first fruits. Talk about how this Discipleship Moment ties in with that concept.
 - b. God asks us to give of all our resources – financial, material, time, and labors. Talk about how this Discipleship Moment ties in with that concept.
 - c. God asks us to grow. Talk about how this Discipleship Moment ties in with that concept.
 - d. Suggested Scriptures for your reading and discovery: Ephesians 5:1-2; Malachi 3:10; Matthew 9:37; 2 Corinthians 9:10
